The Kaluza Family is in need of a specially-equipped house with an open floor plan, overhead lifts, voice activated doors, telephones and appliances.

Thanks to the extreme generosity of the Mahoning Valley community, the home is currently under construction on Youngstown's south side just down the road from their current home. While we believe the "lion's share" of the costs of building the home have been secured with your monetary, material, and labor donations, The Kaluza Project will continue to accept donations at the P.O. After all construction funding is completed, any funds collected will remain in a trust exclusively for the benefit of Joe Kaluza, his wife, and two special needs children.
